1. Minimum 2 & Maximum 4 participants per team.

Presentation Rules (During Evaluation)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be ready to explain in: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>3–5 minutes</b></li> </ul> </li> <li>• Judges check: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Clarity</li> <li>➤ Innovation</li> <li>➤ Technical knowledge</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Stand beside poster and explain confidently</li> </ul>
<p><b>11. Printing Rules</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Use:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>Flex print OR glossy paper</b></li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Ensure:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>High resolution images</b></li> <li>➤ <b>No spelling mistakes</b></li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<p><b>12. Pro Tips (To Win)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Use <b>flow diagrams</b></li> <li>➤ Highlight <b>key results in bold</b></li> <li>➤ Add <b>real photos of project</b></li> <li>➤ Use <b>color coding for sections</b></li> <li>➤ Keep it <b>simple but impactful</b></li> </ul>

14. Time provided is for Poster/Model presentation - **5 min** & Q/A – **2 min**.

15. Participants should bring **two hard copies of project summary** at the time of competition and submit it to student coordinator.

**JUDGING CRITERIA:** Participants may present their project using a working model, prototype along with poster. Poster presentations are also acceptable. Evaluation will be based on innovation, effectiveness, achievement of objectives, communication skills, and performance in the Q&A round.
