TOPICS:

Following topics are considered, but students can present poster on any engineering related topic.

1. Power Quality
2. Non-Conventional Energy Sources.
3. Smart Grid / DC Grid
4. Advanced Energy Storage System.
5. Recent Trends in Engineering.

GUIDELINES:

1. Poster Competition is exclusively for the UG and Diploma Students.
2. Registration Fee: Rs.50/- per participant.
3. Each team may consist of maximum 2 participants.
4. Only one poster will be allowed to present per team.
5. Name of Student and Institute name should appear on the backside of the poster.
6. All lettering and diagrams should be large enough to be read from a minimum of 2 feet.
7. The official language for the poster will be English.
8. Poster Size: maximum 1m x 1m (Printed or Hand Made).
9. All participants will receive participation certificates.
10. Marks will be based on theme, creativity, efforts taken, scientific content and presentation.
11. Decision of the judges/committee will be final.
12. Prizes: 1st Prize - Rs.2000/-, 2nd Prize – Rs.1000/-.
13. Participants should not enroll their names and college/Institutes name on the poster
14. The team member/members should be present during the poster presentation session.
15. Participant has to explain their poster content to the committee and visitors.
16. The authors should arrive at least one hour before the poster session starts.
17. For registration and more information contact to the coordinators on or before 17 April 2026.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

1. Content (Selection of Topic) (15 marks)
2. Uniqueness of poster (use of new idea, creative approach) (5 marks)
3. Its Presentation (10 marks)
4. Question and Answers (10 marks)
5. Overall impact of poster (Poster Format and Appearance) (10 marks)
6. Total Marks = 50
7. The participants will be given a maximum of three to five minutes to present their poster before the panel.
8. **All the decisions made by judges and event head will be final.**

9. Violation of any rule mentioned above can lead to disqualification of the poster at any of the time.
10. The organizers reserve the right to change/update the rules of the contest at any time and will do their best to inform the participants about the same.

GUIDELINES:

- 1) This competition is open to all Undergraduates and Diploma students from Electrical Engineering.
- 2) The project must be in the form of working model/ software / simulation based/ industry Sponsored / Experimental basis.
- 3) No limit for team per institute.
- 4) Maximum 4 participants per team.
- 5) Project abstract must be submitted before the competition on or before **17 April 2026**.
- 6) Project Abstract must of 1page A4 size in Microsoft Word format containing Project Title, Name, and email id of the participant.
- 7) Specific requirement to demonstrate the project (if any) should be well informed to the organizer.
- 8) Maximum time for demonstration will be 05 min & 2min to question answer session for judges.
- 9) All participants should be present with their models / software / simulation / industry Sponsored / Experimental basis project at the time of assessment and should answer the questions asked by the judges.
- 10) The decision given by judges in all matters will be final.
- 11) Participants have to carry two hard copies of project report for competition

- 2) Innovation originality and achievement of the objective.
- 3) Application / practical utility to industry/ Agricultural / Society.
- 4) Work-ability of the project.
- 5) Commercial potential if any.
